Flight of the Phoenix lands in Downtown Miami

Dennis Quaid and Giovanni Ribisi currently star in the movie "Flight of the Phoenix" in which a group of air-crash survivors are stranded in the Mongolian desert with no chance of rescue. Facing a brutal environment, dwindling resources, and an attack by desert smugglers, they realize their only hope is doing the 'impossible': building a new plane from the wreckage.

The airplane featured in the movie is a C-119 Fairchild better known as the 'Flying Boxcar'. InterFlight Studio, a Miami firm, represents an artist who had his own Flight of the Phoenix. Giancarlo de Astis used the aileron (part of the wing) of an original C-119 to create "Il Primo" a

phenomenal desk for people with a taste for adventure and a love for aviation (US \$12,000).
